The Fraternal Order of Police of Ohio Foundation is seeking nominations for Ohio's outstanding Law Enforcement Officer for the year 2020. This award is presented to an officer who, while in the line of duty, performed an act of extraordinary bravery or rendered life-saving aid to victim(s) of criminal conduct or medical emergencies.

Any law enforcement officer certified by the Ohio Peace Officers Training Council is eligible to be nominated. You do not need to be a member of the Fraternal Order of Police to be considered for or win this award.

The action for which the officer is nominated must have occurred between January 1, 2019 and December 31, 2019.

Nominations must be submitted by an agency or political subdivision for whom the law enforcement officer works, an Ohio law enforcement officer, or an FOP Lodge. **The deadline for submitting nominations is May 3, 2020.** Send nominations to:
